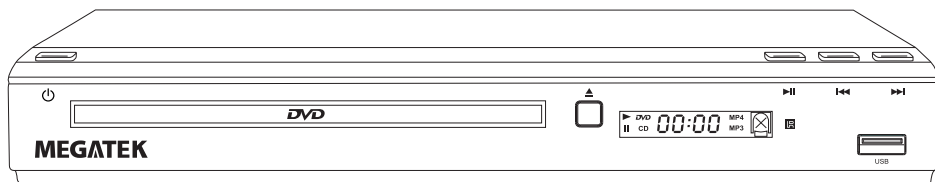

- This unit supports USB2.0 High Speed.
- This unit supports an HDD formatted in FAT32. If the HDD is not recognized the power to the HDD may not be supplied. Supply power from an external source.

Unit and Disc Care

Clean this unit with a soft, dry cloth.

- Never use alcohol, paint thinner or benzene to clean this unit.
- Before using chemically treated cloth, read the instructions that came with the cloth carefully.
- Cleaning of the lens is generally not necessary although this depends on the operating environment.
- Do not use commercially available lens cleaners as they may cause malfunction.

Clean discs

- Wipe with a damp cloth and then wipe dry.



Disc Handling Precautions

- Handle discs by the edges to avoid inadvertent scratches or fingerprints on the disc.
- Do not attach labels or stickers to discs.
- Do not use record cleaning sprays, benzene, thinner, static electricity prevention liquids or any other solvent.
- Do not use the following discs:
 - Discs with exposed adhesive from removed stickers or labels (rented discs etc.).
 - Discs that are badly warped or cracked.
 - Irregularly shaped discs, such as heart shapes.
- The digital audio content side of a DualDisc does not meet the technical specifications of the Compact Disc Digital Audio (CD-DA) format so playback may not be possible.

Inserting the Batteries

Insert 2 AAA batteries (not supplied) into the battery compartment of the remote control before using it.

1. Slide to remove the cover of the battery compartment.
2. Insert the batteries with their poles (+ and –) matching those marks in the remote control's battery compartment.
3. Slide back the cover of the battery compartment.

TIP:

To use the remote control, point it directly towards the remote control sensor on the front panel of the DVD player.

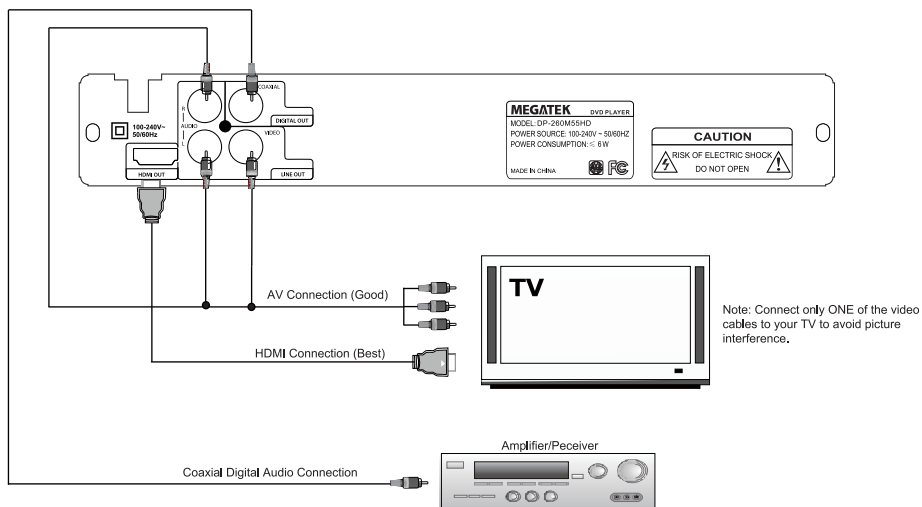
SYSTEM CONNECTIONS

Power source

Use the polarized AC line cord provided for operation on AC power. Insert the AC cord plug into a standard 120V~60Hz polarized AC outlet. If you cause a static discharge when touching your player and your player fails to function, unplug your player from the AC outlet and plug it back in. Your player should return to normal operation.

Warnings

- The system uses a polarized AC plug with one wide blade and one narrow blade. The plug will only fit into matching polarized power outlets. This is a safety feature to reduce the possibility of electric shock. If the plug will not fit in your power outlets, you probably have outdated, non-polarized outlets which should be changed by a qualified, licensed electrician. Do not file the wide blade on the plug or use an adapter to make the plug fit into your outlet.



Note: Connect only ONE of the video cables to your TV to avoid picture interference.

Video connection

Caution:

Do not plug in the AC power plug until you have finished making the system connections.

To connect to your TV with a video cable:

- Connect one of the **VIDEO OUT** jacks (HDMI, or composite) on your player to the corresponding **VIDEO IN** jack on the TV (see illustration)

Audio connection

To connect to your TV with audio source:

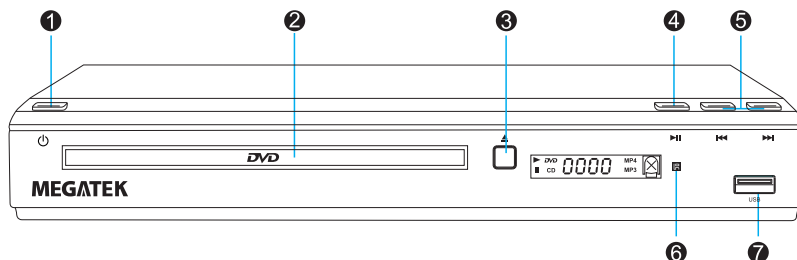
- Connect the left and right **AUDIO OUT** jacks on the back of your player to the audio left and right in jacks on the **TV** using the supplied audio cables. (No need of the above audio connection in case of HDMI connection).

To connect a two-channel digital stereo or A/V receiver with multi-channel decoder:

- Connect your player's **COAXIAL DIGITAL AUDIO OUT** jack to the corresponding in jack on your amplifier. Use a coaxial digital audio cable (not supplied).

PRODUCT OVERVIEW

Front View



1. Power button

Press to switch the unit from on to standby mode or vice versa. In standby mode, the unit is still consuming a small amount of power.

2. Disc tray

When inserting a disc, ensure that it's label side is facing the right way up.

3. OPEN/CLOSE

Opens/closes the disc tray.

4. Play / Pause

Starts or pauses playback.

5. Skip

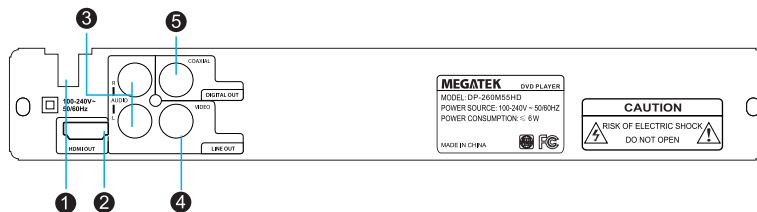
- Skips to previous title/chapter/track or next title/chapter/track.
- Switches the MENU page of VCD equipped with Playback Control (PBC) function.

6. Remote Control Receiver

7. USB port

Connects a USB device.

1. Power-supply cord

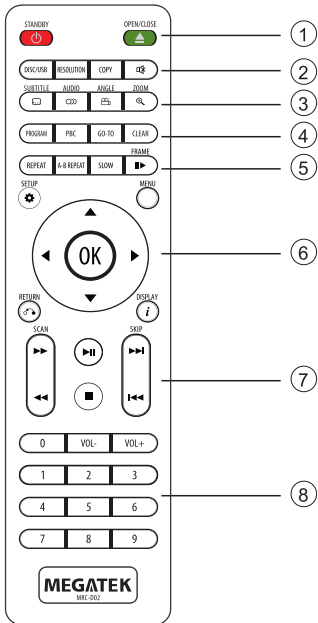
2. HDMI out

REMOTE CONTROL GUIDE



① Standby/Power On switch

Press to switch the unit from on to standby mode or vice versa. In standby mode, the unit is still consuming a small amount of power.

OPEN/CLOSE

Opens/closes the disc tray.

② DISC/USB

Switches to the USB mode / Returns to the disc mode

RESOLUTION

Selects the type of video signal output. Press this button repeatedly to have the player output video signals of the highest resolution acceptable for your TV. If the picture is not clear, unnatural or otherwise not to your satisfaction, try another option that suits the disc, TV/projector, etc. For details, refer also to the instruction manual supplied with the TV/projector, etc.

COPY

Records music contents from loaded CD disc to inserted USB drive.

MUTE

Press to enable/disable the audio output.

③ SUBTITLE

Shows and selects different subtitle.

AUDIO

Changes soundtracks.

ANGLE

Switches the camera angle.

ZOOM

Magnifies/shrinks the image up to four times the original size, scroll using .

④ PROGRAM

Sets the playback order.

1. Press to select the item.

2. Press 0 to 9 to specify the 2-digit order.

e.g., 5: 0 5

15: 1 5

To cancel: Press CLEAR.

3. Press to select Start, press OK to start programmed playback.

4. Press STOP twice to clear the whole program.

PBC

Sets PBC of VCD equipped with Playback Control (PBC) function to On/Off.

GO-TO

Specifies the point of time where you would like to start playback.

CLEAR

Clear the input information.

⑤ REPEAT

Selects various repeat mode, or starts random playback.

A-B REPEAT

Specifies the parts you want to play repeatedly.

1. During playback, press A-B REPEAT to specify starting point (point A).

2. When you reach the ending point (point B), press it again.

SLOW

Plays back at 1/2, 1/3, 1/4, 1/5, 1/6, or 1/7 of the original speed.

FRAME

Plays Video frame by frame.

REMOTE CONTROL GUIDE (Cont.)

⑥ **SETUP**

Enters or exits the system setup menu.

MENU: Displays the menu.



Selects items, input position, etc.

– For moving the display position of enlarged images

– For rotating JPEG images

OK

Confirms menu selection.

RETURN 

(DVD disc menu only).

Returns to the previous display.

DISPLAY

Displays information on TV screen during playback.

⑦ **SCAN**

Starts fast reverse or fast forward.

PLAY/PAUSE  

Starts or pauses playback.

STOP 

Stops playback.

SKIP  

- Skips to previous title/chapter/track or next title/chapter/track.
- Switches the MENU page of VCD equipped with Playback Control (PBC) function.

⑧ **0-9**

To select title/chapter/track numbers etc.

e.g., 5: 5
 15: 1 → 5

VOL-VOL+

Decreases/increases the audio output.

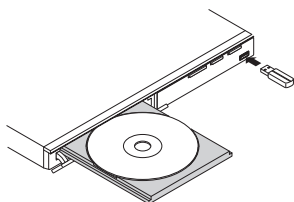
USING YOUR DVD PLAYER

Powering your DVD player

- ① Make sure that your DVD player is connected to power.
- ② Press **⏻** (POWER) button on the top left of your DVD player, or on the remote control, to turn it on. The start-up picture appears on the screen.
- ③ Press **⏻** (POWER) button on the top left of DVD player, or on the remote control, to turn it off.

Playing a DVD or audio CD, or USB

- ① Turn on the TV and select the correct video input.
- ② Press **⏻** to turn on your player.
- ③ Place a disc or connect a USB device.



- If this unit is not switched to the USB mode when connecting the USB device, press USB button on the remote control.
- Depending on the disc, playback may start automatically.
(JPEG Only)
- When you press PLAY/PAUSE **▶/⏸** instead of OK, you can start the slide show.

Stopping playback

Press **STOP ■**.

The stopped position is memorized.

Power Resume function

Press PLAY/PAUSE **▶/⏸** to restart from this position.

This position is memorized even after power outage (Power Resume). However, if the restart position is misaligned or depending on the media and playback conditions, the unit may not operate normally.

NOTE

- Screen saver will start automatically if the media playback is stopped and the menu is closed for about 5 minutes.
- The player will automatically switch to Power Standby mode if you do not press any buttons for about 25 minutes after the media has stopped playing.

Controlling DVD or audio CD playback

- Press **■** (STOP) once to stop playback. Your DVD player remembers where you stopped. If you press **▶⏸**, your DVD player starts playing at the point where you stopped.
- Press **■** (STOP) twice to stop playback. If you press **▶⏸**, your DVD player starts playing at the beginning of the disc.
- Press **▶⏸** to pause playback. Press this button again to resume playback.
- Press **▶▶** to fast-forward the disc. Each time you press this button, the fast-forward speed changes from 2 to 4 to 8 to 20 times the normal speed.
- Press **◀◀** to fast-reverse the disc. Each time you press this button, the fast-reverse speed changes from 2 to 4 to 8 to 20 times the normal speed.
- Press **▶▶** (NEXT) to skip to the next title, chapter, or track.
- Press **◀◀** (PREV) to skip to the previous title, chapter, or track.

Adjusting the volume

- Press **VOL-** or **VOL+** to decrease or increase the volume.
- Adjust the volume of playback by turning it up or down on your TV, stereo system, or home theater.

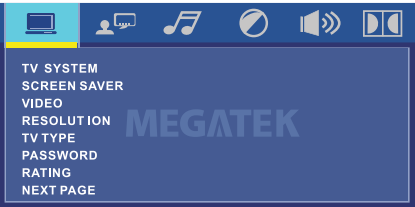
Programming your DVD player

- 1 Insert a disc into the DVD player.
- 2 Press the PROG button on the remote control.
- 3 Select the chapter number you want to play, from the list on the screen.
- 4 Press **▶⏸** to begin playback.

CHANGING THE PLAYER SETTINGS

Your DVD player has a Setup menu you can use to adjust settings. To change your player's settings:

- 1. Press **SETUP** on the remote control. The Setup Menu opens on your TV or monitor.



- 2. Press **◀** or **▶** to select a different menu, or press **▼** or **▲** to highlight an item on the displayed menu.
- 3. When you have selected an item on the menu, press **OK** to change the setting for that item. A sub-menu with setting options is displayed.
- 4. Press **▼** or **▲** to highlight your desired setting, then press **OK** to confirm your setting.
- 5. Press **SETUP** to exit the menu.

SYSTEM SETUP	<p>TV SYSTEM—Select NTSC, PAL, or AUTO.</p> <p>SCREEN SAVER—Turn screen saver On or Off.</p> <p>VIDEO-CVBS—Outputs composite video via VIDEO port. (This setting is unchangeable.)</p> <p>RESOLUTION—There are five options for the HDMI port: 480I/576I, 480P/576P, 720P, 1080I, or 1080P. (The number indicates the vertical resolution. TROUBLESHOOTING

Please check for causes of problems in accordance with the following chart before contacting any maintenance personnel.

Symptom	What to check
The player does not play.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- If disc is loaded in.- If disc is loaded upside down.- If disc is dirty or warped.- If water condensation has occurred. If it occurs, take out disc and leave the player on for a few hours until it backs to normal.
There is no sound.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- If the volume of either your player or the connected TV/receiver is set to "0".- If the system connection is correct.- If the power of speakers is turned on.- Make sure the input for the TV and stereo system are correct.- If the sound setup of DVD disc is correct.- If disc is dirty or warped.
There is no picture.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- If TV is turned on and is in correct video mode.- If system connection is correct.
Poor AV performance.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- If disc is dirty, warped or damaged.
Cannot continue to play and play a section repeatedly.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- If it is in A-B repeat status. If it is true, press A-B button to cancel.- If disc is dirty or damaged. If it is true, clean it or skip the section.
The remote control does not work.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- If there are obstructions between the remote control and the player.- If the remote control is pointing at the player.- If batteries are inserted or the polarity is correct.- If batteries are weak.

Note:

Static or other external interference may cause the abnormality of the player. At this circumstance, unplug the power - supply cord from the outlet and plug it in again to reset the player so that the normal operation will be resumed. If you are still having problems, then please disconnect the power and consult your service center or a qualified technician.
